Items to consider

Availability of child care

Reliable Transportation

Best supplemental jobs will be in service areas - restaurants, sales, hotel, etc. Pay is usually minimum wage. Plus many need applicants to work nights, holidays, & weekends.

Most supplemental employment will be 10-20 hours per week, depending on the number of hours worked at main job.

Most of these jobs require a flexible schedule, ability to work weekends & holidays (many applicants will not be able to accept these jobs as it will conflict with main job or personal life).

Look carefully at what they are doing and time available.
